

ICDP implementasjon in Kwazulu Natal, South Africa



Kwazulu Natal



- The region in Kwazulu Natal is the epicenter for HIV/AIDS, and many children has lost one or both of their parents. Demographic the township has the same challenges as the rest of South Africa with 30% analphabets and a high percent of unemployment.
- ICDP has been implementet in two areas;
 - The township of Gamalakhe
 - The city of Pietermaritsburg

ICDP Implementation Gamalakhe

- A corporation between Gamalakhe Development Center, R-bup and International Child Developmental Program (ICDP)
- Facilitator training once a year since 2010 with three seminars a year
- A total of 40 certified ICDP facilitators
 - 250 caregivers have participated in the sensitization process.



ICDP Implementation Pietermaritzburg

- A corporation between Dlalanathi, Cindi Network and ICDP
- Facilitator training
 - One group of 20 certified facilitators, this group came from many different organizations working in the psychosocial field.





Related activities

The translation of ICDP materials into zulu

- Follow up seminars/ supervision of the already trained facilitators
- Participation in the African network meetings
- A evaluation of the results of the implemtations are being carried out in by a master student at the University of Oslo, Norway

Sustainability – trainer level

- A trainer's seminar is scheduled to start in november in 2012. The participants will be selected facilitators from Gamalakhe, Pietermaritsburg and Malawi, altogether 15 participants.
- The plan is to create a strong group of ICDP trainers who afterwards can sustain the ICDP work in these countries.
