Testimony 1: Kay Myant Myant Lwin

I am very happy to attend the ICDP meeting. I get to know more about how to deal with my one and half year old daughter. Before, I did not pay attention to my daughter, I just focused on my job. I used to leave my daughter with my parents and go to work in another town. As a result, my daughter and I did not have a good attunement. It hurt me. I did not know how it is important to listen to my kid, to show love, give

completements. But now I pay attention more, I know this is important to myself, my parents, my daughter. Now I decided to take care of my daughter even though I had some problems.

Testimony 2: Kyi Khaing

Before, I was out of control if related to my two kids' stuff. If my kids misbehave and do not listen to me I just smack and beat up right away with anger. I did think about my kids' feelings. I thought I would punish them to improve their behaviors. I did not let them speak out and share their feelings. I did not even ask their feelings. My kids feared me, they did not trust me.

Now when I meet my kids misbehave, I start mentalize myself first then respond to my kids. I asked a question, I listened to my kids, I explained and the thing I changed is I never beaten up my kids. I feel like my kids and I had trust and getting close to me. They come to me, share things in school, hug me.

Testimony 3:: Fai found a surprising in a Big cleaning day

Fai is a single woman age 31 years old, graduated from the Bible school. She had experience working as the assistant of Sunday School teacher assistant. Now she has been working as a caregiver in the emergency safety house of women for 2 years. Her role in this house is to care for young girls/ women who faced difficulties in life (family broken, parents addicted to drugs, sexual abuse).

In the ICDP meeting, we have time to chat with each other during the break and after end the meeting. She shared(complained) that working with young women who had different background is not easy. Her job made her headaches often, because the young girls do not respond or reacts according to the assignment she commanded and they are sensitive to irritate. Fai feels not happy with this job.

In the meeting 4th of ICDP, she shared testimony through a VIDIO clip. (There were round 8-15 young girls are cleaning the big kitchen room). Fai said that she was so surprised at that day, because all girls were so harmonized and joyful on that big cleaning day, no one ignores the task or made any problems, everyone were so happy.

She thought that the situation/ feeling of all people on that day changed in positive, because she adapted the knowledge from ICDP in her job and daily life.

She recognized that: we have different backgrounds (someone is in deep trauma and so sensitive to anger, sadness, etc emotions), but we need same, it is empathy/ value and be loved)

Before starting the big cleaning, she talked to the girls with a soft voice and politely instead of commanding them. She took time to talk with the one who takes the role of in chart of the house. She required help from them “please you help to do this / could you please help me instead of today you have to do that!. And praised them that you did very well, you have good skills/ ability and thank you so much for your help. We will work togerger.

Understanding the overall content and growth phase of the organization because the teaching materials are not a package that can be understood immediately requires a lot of time to be translated and prepared before being able to promote and drive the work.

We've started talking about bringing in ICDP programs to teach each area.

1. We want to have trainers of Thailand, which has now taken 2 modules.
