1. The team of facilitators and trainers are volunteers, each of whom has different free time, and the time for this year is quite small. This makes it impossible for us to continue to do groups.
2. Thai organizations do not have a budget for training in this matter. Therefore, we need to find a budget to take care of the team from government agencies to prepare. It takes a long time to budget
